House Rules for Tuin van Epicurus - Nature Camping

1. Respect for Nature

- Leave no trace: Keep the campsite clean. All waste must be sorted and disposed of in the designated recycling bins at the parking lot.
- No picking plants or disturbing wildlife. Please respect the flora and fauna around you.
- Campfires are only allowed in designated areas. Use firewood provided by the campsite and never collect wood from the surrounding. Please do not throw anything else in the fire, just paper and wood.
- Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas. Please ensure that
 cigarettes and other smoking materials are disposed of properly to avoid fires and
 maintain cleanliness.

2. Cleanliness and Maintenance

- All guests are responsible for keeping the common areas of the campsite such as the Greenhouse, the sanitary rooms, and the outdoor facilities clean and tidy. The Yoga Floor should only be used for its purpose. Please don't step on it / walk over it with your shoes on.
- We kindly ask our **Airbnb Guests** to **keep their accommodations clean and orderly**. At the end of your stay, please **ensure that your space is left in a tidy condition**.
- The washing machine and dryer are available exclusively for staff use. Please do not use these appliances for personal laundry.
- Please do not flush anything down the toilet that does not belong. Only flush the
 provided toilet paper and human waste. Examples of items that should not be
 flushed include: Wet Wipes (even if labeled as flushable) / Paper Towels / Tissues /
 Food Scraps / Cigarette Butts / Feminine Hygiene Products / Plastic Items...etc.
 Improper use of the toilets can lead to clogs and damage, affecting everyone's
 experience.
- Bikes and Boats are available for free for all the camping guests during the designated hours. Please make sure that you read and follow the additional rules at the bike racks / at the dock.
 - Report any damage or issues to the camping manager immediately.

3. Quiet Hours

- Quiet hours are from 23:00 to 08:00. Please respect other campers and the neighborhood by keeping noise to a minimum during this time
- No amplified music is allowed at any time.

4. Sustainable Camping

- The use of the provided eco-friendly products (soaps, shampoos, etc.) is mandatory to protect our septic tanks. If your sanitary house ran out of hygiene products or toilet paper, just ask the manager for a refill. Using chemical products in our sanitaries is strictly forbidden.
- It is not possible to empty chemical toilets from caravans or RVs at our campsite. Please ensure that your chemical toilet is properly emptied and serviced at a designated facility before arriving at our site.
- Water conservation is important. Please use water wisely and avoid wastage.
- Solar-powered devices or low-energy consumption equipment are encouraged.

5. Pets

- Pets are welcome, but they must be kept on a leash at all times.
- Please clean up after your pets and dispose of waste properly.
- Ensure that your pet does not disturb other campers or wildlife.

6. Vehicles and Parking

- Cars are only allowed in the **designated parking areas**. The campsite itself is car-free to preserve peace and the environment.
- **Bicycles** are a preferred method of transportation on the campsite. You can get one for free at the reception.

7. Campfires and Cooking

- Campfires are allowed only in the **designated fire pits**. The fireplace may be used until midnight.
- Barbecues are permitted, but they must be raised off the ground to avoid damaging the grass.
- Never leave a fire or barbecue unattended, and make sure it is fully extinguished before leaving it.

8. Check-In and Check-Out

- Check-in is from 12:00 on the camping spots and from 14:00 in the
 accommodations, and check-out is by 11:00 to allow time for site preparation for new
 guests.
- Late departures are subject to availability and incur an additional fee.
- All guests and visitors need to register themselves at the reception first.

9. Children

- Children are welcome but must be **supervised at all times**, especially around the fire pits, at water features and in the Greenhouse.
- We encourage outdoor play but ask that noise is kept moderate to maintain the peaceful atmosphere.

10. Group Bookings

Group bookings are allowed but must be approved in advance. Please ensure that all
group members respect the campsite's tranquility and the house rules. The person who
made the booking is responsible for the group.

11. Emergencies

• In case of an emergency, please contact the campsite manager immediately. First aid kits and emergency contact numbers are available at the reception.

12. Non-Compliance:

• Failure to adhere to these rules may result in additional fees or other penalties, as outlined in our terms and conditions.
